Special Council Meeting

CALLED TO ORDER:

Mayor Paul Markgraf opened the meeting of the Special Meeting of Lakeside Park City Council at 9:04 AM Saturday, January 28, 2023. Those in attendance were Council Members: Mary Ann Thaman, Tom Bernheimer, Dave Wolfer, Brian Waite, Chris Gongola, Dennis Landwehr, also, in attendance City Clerk, Teresa Bruck and Public Works, Steve Greer.

CITY CLERK/TREASURER REPORT:

Teresa Bruck gave treasury report and concerns with QuickBooks application needs prior years from 2009 to 2015 purged to hard drive or upgrade for QuickBooks application.

PUBLIC WORKS:

Steve Greer talked about his Public Works inventory and items needed to be restocked. Council advised ok to order needed items.

UPCOMING PROJECTS AND DISCUSSION:

Steve Greer talked about estimates for items suggested to improve the City such as park benches, garbage receptacles, pet water fountains, trimming of trees and planting of trees as just some of the ideas discussed for city improvement. Many more ideas were brought to the table to consider and discussed further during the upcoming budget meeting.

Mayor Markgraf discussed that there are plans to meet with Kenton County Zoning to review upcoming zoning changes that included 5 residential zones going down to 3. At present, the City does not have commercial zoning and the City needs more details about individuals working from home and home businesses.

Brian Waite suggested we consider working with Crestview Hills that each police unit has their own AED as the department only has 2 AED units and patrol officers have to share.
