

LAKESIDE PARK-CRESTVIEW HILLS POLICE AUTHORITY BOARD

Regular Meeting – March 18, 2024

CALL TO ORDER: The regular meeting of the Lakeside Park-Crestview Hills Police Authority Board was called to order at 1724 hours by Chairman Bill Dorsey.

ATTENDANCE: Board Members in attendance were: Paul Markgraf, Bill Dorsey, Brian Waite & Ed Wise. Dave Kramer was absent. Also present were: Chief Degenhardt, Sgt. Paolucci & Melissa Sies.

MINUTES: Mr. Waite made a motion to accept the February minutes. Mr. Markgraf seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL: The February financial statement was reviewed along with the February reconciliations. After a review of the bills, Mr. Markgraf made a motion to pay the bills, Mr. Wise seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

CHIEF'S REPORT:

- Ptl. Henderson completed Resiliency training through DOCJT.
- Ptl. Steward completed Personal Crimes Investigations course through DOCJT.
- The new cruisers are currently being upfitted and should be in service in a few weeks.
- TMU Student Police Academy has begun. There are 11 students enrolled in the course.

COUNCIL REPORTS:

Crestview Hills – The regular meeting was held on March 14. Mr. Dorsey reported that the city adopted the 2024 Northern Kentucky Hazard Mitigation Plan; there was a 2nd reading creating a City Small Business Incentive Program; they had a 1st reading to amend Chapter 92 entitled “Nuisance” to create noise control regulations; Chief Degenhardt presented the Annual Report.

Lakeside Park – The regular meeting was held on March 11. Mr. Markgraf reported that the city had a 2nd reading of an ordinance to add city liens to the annual property tax bills; new zoning code was passed, limiting the size of signage; Chief Degenhardt presented the Annual Report.


